
Chilling out in Chiplun

The roads of Mumbai-Goa NH 17 are super smooth and you should negotiate the journey in 6 hours, factoring in the two-three breaks along the way - just in time for an early lunch in Chiplun.

Why?

This beautiful town is the the right place to

drop anchor and take day-trips to exotic locales nearby. The sheer sight of the Vashishti river calmly flowing through Chiplun is worth going all the way. Going on a boat ride in the river is a different trip altogether.


Certain stretches are reminiscent of the backwaters of Kerala, while others are straight out of a 'Lost in Amazon' flick. On a lucky day, you get to see swamps of crocodiles soaking the sun on the small islands in the middle of the river.
